Detailed Eligibility Criteria for the test that will be conducted on 20th October 2023 (Friday) is as follows:

- Courses & Discipline: 2024 Year of Passing Graduates from Arts, Commerce & Science Streams. B. Com, BA, BAF, BBI, BBA, BBM, BMS, BSc (Maths, Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology) from a recognized University / College.
- Course Types: Only full-time courses will be considered (part-time / correspondence courses will not be considered). Candidates who have completed their Secondary and / or Senior Secondary course from NIOS(National Institute of Open Schooling) are also eligible to apply if the other courses are full-time.
- Highest Qualification: Candidates should have completed the course in the stipulated course duration (i.e.,
- No extended education 3 years course should have been completed in the stipulated 3 years' time only).
 Backlogs: Only one backlog is permitted for the candidates from the 2024 year of passing, however all pendingbacklogs should be completed within the stipulated course duration.
- Gap / Break in Education: It is mandatory to declare gaps in education if any in the TCS Application Form.
 Overallacademic gap should not exceed 24 months until highest qualification. Relevant document proof, as applicable, will be checked for gaps in education
- Work Experience: As this role is for 'Entry Level Requirement', students are not expected to have any prior experience.
- Age: Minimum age 18 years and Maximum age 28 years

Step 3: Select your mode of test (In-Centre), choose your preferred test centre, Select two joining locations of your preference and then click on Apply. Please Note, test centre once selected cannot be changed.

Step 4: To confirm your status, check 'Track Your Application'. The status should reflect as 'Applied for Drive'.
